

Leadership in Co-Designing Health with Public & Community

Judging Criteria

Judges will score nominations based on the following framework.

1. Impact / 10

Contributions by a team in partnering with a community in the pursuit of improving health quality. Scoring in this category will consider how the nominee involved some aspect of codesign to engage and amplify community voices and what matters to them in advancing the health of their community.

2. Leadership / 15

This category considers how the project team identified an opportunity within a particular community, and supported and motivated the community to work in partnership in pursuit of a common goal.

3. Engagement / 20

The project team inspired communities, patients, caregivers or family members to engage in efforts to improve quality of care; and/or inspired both the community and health care providers to work together in collective action. The nominee's behaviors and actions demonstrated a commitment to and passion for improving health care in partnership WITH the community.
